Pass Tutoring

Robichaud High School believes every student can achieve at high levels. We are committed to promoting student growth and achievement.

Beginning September of 2016, Robichaud High School is offering a free afterschool tutoring program to students who are identified as falling below 65% in their core classes. PASS (Promoting Academic Student Success) is a support system allowing all learners the opportunity to reach his or her maximum potential. This program offers tutoring in the four core academic areas of: English, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Students will receive a PASS referral on Friday if their teacher sees they are slipping below a 65%. Students will be required to attend the PASS program during one of the sessions the following week and complete a missing task or test review for that course.

PASS details:

- Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 2:40-3:40
- Complete 1 or more missing tasks for that class.
- If a test score is the concern, a teacher may ask a student to complete review work before retaking the test.
- A teacher will be available for assistance.
- There will be computers available for student use.

It is our hope that by catching students before they slip below the 65% mark, we can ensure all students achieve academic success in their core classes..
